



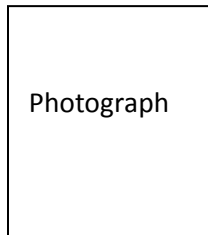

Prof Qoumrul Hoque Memorial Endowment for International Fellowship

The ERD Foundation has created “Prof Qoumrul Hoque Memorial Endowment” in memory of late Prof Qoumrul Hoque, for supporting underprivileged meritorious International students for pursuing higher education in the University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya and Regional Institute of Science and Technology, the two institutions promoted by ERDF. In pursuance of Govt of India’s Act East Policy and to create cooperation and brotherhood among neighboring countries, during the academic session 2016-17, “Prof Qoumrul Hoque Memorial Endowment” will sponsor 20 underprivileged meritorious students of Bangladesh and offer scholarship to pursue higher education in these two ERDF Institutions under the International Fellowship Scheme of the Endowment.

Instructions:

1. Students seeking admission in the aforesaid categories will have to satisfy the eligibility criteria of **securing minimum 65% marks in qualifying examination** for admission to the programmes as prescribed by the University. But merely fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria does not guarantee the selection of a candidate into any program.
2. Candidates holding Bangladesh passports will be eligible to apply for this scheme.
3. **Total Fellowship offered is 20 with 8 Fellowship for B. Tech course and 12 Fellowship for USTM with not more than one Fellowship in each course at USTM.**
4. **Fellowship is equivalent to normal fee structure** as given in the course details.
5. The **Fellowship covers Admission Fees and the Semester Fees; Hostel Fees and Examination Fees are not included in the Fellowship.** (Students can stay on their own in the vicinity of USTM/RIST).
6. List of selected candidates shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the university as well as in the USTM’s website. The candidates are required to get their admission completed by the date given in the schedule.
7. **Last Date of Form Submission is 25th June, 2016.**
8. **Declaration of Merit List** based on criteria prescribed by the university will be notified **on or before 5th July, 2016.**
9. **Students on getting the Provisional Admission Letter have to obtain the Student Visa from the Indian Embassy in Bangladesh and get the Student Visa endorsed to USTM/RIST. Students must comply with the rules of both the Govt of Bangladesh & India to pursue higher education in India.**
10. Students must report for completion of admission formalities and for the classes on or before 15th July, 2016 and submit it with the following documents (in original along with a Photostat copy):
 - a. Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination
 - b. Mark list of qualifying examination.
 - c. Student Visa in original.
 - d. A Photostat copy of their passport
 - e. Original certificate of Annual income
11. **Admission formalities to be completed by 15th July, 2016.**
12. Within a week of arrival in India students have to **register their names with the police in the Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO) of the local Police.**
13. The candidates are required to have a minimum of **85% attendance** in all the semesters.
14. The candidates availing the scholarship should be actively involved in all social activities and events of the university.
15. The Code of Conduct of RIST/USTM is applicable to all the students availing the Fellowship.
16. Any other instructions may be implemented from time to time as per norms.
