Chancellor calls on new Visitor to USTM



Mr Mahbubul Hoque, Chancellor, USTM and Chairman of ERDF called on Hon'ble Governor Dr KK Paul at the Raj Bhawan in Shillong on July 31, 2013. It may be mentioned that Dr Paul had taken over as the new Governor of Meghalaya on July 8, 2013. Besides being the Governor of Meghalaya, Dr Paul is also the Visitor to USTM and hence this meeting was of great significance for the University.

A 1970 batch IPS officer Dr Paul joined as a member of Union Public Service Commission in 2007. The most outstanding part of Dr Paul is that his PhD was amongst the first in Police Service. He was also involved in handling some mega events like the Asian Games in 1982, followed by NAM and CHOGM in 1983.

In his first meeting with the Visitor to the University, Hoque offered him a flower bouquet and conveyed best wishes to him on behalf of the entire USTM family.

In a business like conversation, Dr Paul suggested a few useful points to Hoque for the betterment of USTM. Let's hear it in Dr Paul's own words-

- Ensure that the faculty in the University is well qualified and possess an excellent track record before they are taken in for employment.
- Provide wide exposure to the students with the outside world and make sure they become 'employable' before they leave the University.
- Be very careful with the conduct of examinations, a high standard should be maintained and no room left for criticism at a later date. It is very important for you to ensure that your 'seal' is not utilised for malpractices.
- Develop the courses at the University in such a way that they also serve the local needs and aspirations.
- Submit activity report to the Visitor regularly, every month, so that he could give you the required suggestions from time to time.
- There must be emphasis on Research & Development activities followed by regular seminars, workshops, discussions, symposium and other interactive programmes to keep the faculty and students abreast with the latest developments in their respective fields.

Hoque assured the Visitor that all these points would be acted upon with right earnest and thanked Dr Paul for giving time to him. Hoque also requested the Visitor to make a trip to the University and he assured that this would be done at an appropriate time.

Prof Azis joins as Vice-Chancellor



Prof PK Abdul Azis, formerly Vice-Chancellor of Cochin University of Science & Technology and Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) has joined the USTM as its new Vice-Chancellor on 3rd April, 2013.

Prof Azis started his career as Assistant Professor, at the Kerala Agricultural University.

He worked in the University of Kerala as UGC Research Associate, Lecturer, Reader and Professor and in the Research and Development Centre of the Saline Water Conversion Corporation, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia as Chairman and Vice-Chairman at the Department of Ecology and Marine Biology. The University of Kerala awarded Prof Azis the most coveted degree of Doctor of Science (DSc) for his contributions in the field of Ecology in 2004. He was the man behind the pan-Indian expansion of the AMU by establishing AMU centers in Murshidabad (West Bengal) and Malappuram (Kerala).
