Prof Syiemlieh, also a renowned academician is the former Vice Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi University, Arunachal Pradesh. He had also served as Lecturer at St. Edmund's College, Shillong & as a Professor at NEHU. He has authored and edited several books and publications and had been awarded Senior Fulbright Fellowship in the year 1999.

Speaking to a group of more than 200 students from various departments of USTM, Prof. Syiemlieh said "Cracking an UPSC examination is not a Herculean task, one just need to be focused in his life

and plan their moves properly".
