7th Memorial Lecture on the Role of PA Sangma for Progressive Meghalaya







USTM remembered former Lok Sabha Speaker and former Chief Minister of Meghalaya Late Shri PA Sangma on his 8th death anniversary and organized the 7th Memorial Lecture on "Role of PA Sangma for Progressive Meghalaya" on 4th March 2024. The lecture was delivered by Shri RS Mooshahary, Former Governor of Meghalaya in the presence of Shri Mahbubul Hoque, Chancellor of USTM, Prof GD Sharma, Vice Chancellor of USTM, a host of faculty members, staff, and hundreds of students.

Addressing the gathering, Shri RS Mooshahary said that Late PA Sangma was the face of the North East, a legendary politician, and a forthright man dedicated to his work. "One of his most important achievements is that, like him, his children too are most civilized, there is no allegation of corruption against them. Shri Conrad Sangma is the most civilized Chief Minister of India", he said.

Shri Mahbubul Hoque said that USTM is highly grateful to Late PA Sangma as he had a vital role during the enactment of the USTM Act in the Meghalaya Assembly in 2008. "Late PA Sangma was a visionary who wanted to nurture young minds through education. He was always a mentor and well-wisher and USTM is committed to him, particularly for his support and encouragement in our initiative to establish a higher educational institution in the state of Meghalaya". Prof GD Sharma made the concluding remarks and stated that Late PA Sangma was a person very well connected to people and helped Meghalaya to develop and shine.

Padma Shri Smt Parbati Baruah received USTM Social Work Excellence Award

Faculty Researcher from USTM discovers new plant in Lohit district

Researchers from USTM, in association with researchers from CSIR-Northeast Institute of Science and Technology, Jorhat, have recently identified and described a novel flowering plant named "Begonia naraharii B. Hajong, N. Bhat & P. Bharali". This discovery took place in the Lohit district of Arunachal Pradesh.

Dr. Nazir Ahmad Bhat, Assistant Professor at USTM, and Mr. Bipankar Hajong, PhD Scholar at CSIR-NEIST have spotted and collected some interesting individuals belonging to the genus







Begonia of the family Begoniaceae. They were helped and guided by Dr. Pankaj Bharali, Senior scientist at CSIR-NEIST. The specimens were packed and brought to the laboratory for analysis. After critical evaluation of these specimens and comparing them with all the known species of Begonia in the world, its identity was confirmed as an undescribed and new species within the genus Begonia.

USTM Chemistry Student selected for European Union Scholarship

Mr. Mustafizur Rahman, a BSC-6th Semester student from the Department of Chemistry at USTM has been selected for the esteemed Erasmus Mundus Scholarship for MSC on Materials for Energy Storage and Conversion (MESC) in the European Union. This scholarship covers universities in Poland, France, Spain, Slovenia, and the USA.Only 36 students globally have been chosen for this program, marking the first time a student from North-East India has been selected for Erasmus Mundus MESC. According to the email from Prof Alejandro A. Franco mailed on 25th March, after the evaluation of Mustafizur's application, they have ranked him on the main list of their selected students and he



is "eligible for an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Scholarship to pursue his studies within i-MESC, starting September 2024".

Expressing his feelings on this outstanding achievement, Mustafizur Rahman said, "I would like to express my gratitude to the European Commission for the prestigious scholarship. Thanks to my supervisor Dr.Sarifuddin Gazi, a highly qualified esteemed professor and Head of the Dept. of Chemistry, USTM for continuously mentoring and guiding me during the whole B.Sc. course". He further stated, "The Department of Chemistry has given me immense exposure in academic and research activities and paid continuous attention at every step during the application. I am very excited to represent India in the i-MESC program, and aspiring to excel as a material chemist".
