

It has also received the necessary approval from AICTE, New Delhi; NCTE, ERC, Bhubaneswar; Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi; BCI, New Delhi; NCISM, New Delhi and NMC, New Delhi to run B.Tech, MBA; B.Ed.; D. Pharm, B. Pharm & M.Pharm; BALLB (H), BBA LLB(H), LLB(H) & LLM; BAMS and MBBS Programmes respectively. USTM offers UG, PG courses & Ph.D. under its different schools viz., School of Applied Sciences, School of Allied Medical Sciences, School of Biological Sciences, School of Technology & Management, School of Social Sciences & Humanities, PQH School of Education, University School of Law and Research, School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, IA Ayurvedic Medical College, PA Sangma International Medical College, Regional Institute of Nursing Education.
