#### **USTM Rises to 34th Rank in Nature Index Surpassing Premier Universities**

The Department of Physics at the University of Science and Technology Meghalaya has been ranked at an unprecedented 34th position by the prestigious Nature Index-2024, surpassing many premier institutions of the nation in this highly competitive global research platform. At the same time, the Nature Index database, curated by Springer Nature, has ranked USTM at an impressive 48th position in terms of research outputs.

Prof GD Sharma, Vice Chancellor of USTM said that this recognition comes as a reward for the institution's commitment to cutting-edge research, innovation, and academic excellence. By consistently pushing the boundaries of scientific discovery, USTM is emerging as a leading research hub in the country.

The Nature Index is a global database that tracks high-quality research output in the natural sciences. It is maintained by Nature Research and measures institutional and

country-level performance based on research publications in 82 prestigious scientific journals covering disciplines such as physics, chemistry, earth sciences, and life sciences.



# **USTM Robotics among top 12 teams in India at Aqua Hackathon**

USTM Robotics was selected as one of the top 12 teams in India at the prestigious Aqua Hackathon conducted by Technology Incubation Centre (TIC) and Technology Innovation Hub (TIDF), IIT Guwahati. The team had Musabbir Islam from the Department of Physics and Sakib Alam from BTech CSE. They presented their idea on Aqua Robotics and AI, securing their place among the best teams from across the country on 17th March 2025.

The Robotics team of USTM participated in a 5-day residential bootcamp at IIT Guwahati, where they developed their projects further. They presented their final output of their Al-powered submarine, named "FIISHY.AI", on 21st March 2025. The 5-day Hackathon and Workshop on Underwater Robotics, organized by IITG-TIC and IITG-TIDF, is a one-of-a-kind event in the niche field of underwater robotics. Participants from Tamil Nadu, Odisha, Tripura, and Assam showcased their talents in this cutting-edge domain.



#### The 3rd USLR Intra Department Moot Court Competition 2025

The 3rd Intra-Department Moot Court Competition, organized by the USLR Students' Forum at USTM was held on 6th and 7th April 2025.

The event brought together budding legal minds who showcased their advocacy skills and legal acumen before a distinguished panel of judges, including Kanak Kharkongor, Assistant Legal Aid Counsel at the District and Sessions Court, Dr. Baharul Islam, Dean of USLR, USTM, and Abdul Rashid, Associate Professor, Department of Commerce, USTM

The competition unfolded through multiple stages, including the semi-finals and the grand finale, where the best teams competed for the championship title. Participants presented well-researched arguments, confidently responded to judicial queries, and demonstrated their ability to think critically under pressure.


